# Honiton u3a

The new year of talks organised by Honiton u3a kicks off at 2 p.m. on Wednesday April 17th, when Helen Baggott gives a talk entitled "From Bombs to Bournville". Her illustrated talk includes the story of a family who helped build torpedoes and buildings. And she discusses the story of a man from Cornwall whose invention transformed manufacturing on both sides of the Atlantic.

May 15<sup>th</sup> sees Toni Hiscocks give a talk about Hospiscare, which does such important work in our community. Hospiscare supports nearly 2,000 patients and their families every year across Exeter, Mid and East Devon, and needs to raise around £10 million a year to continue doing so. Just 18 per cent of the charity's income comes from the NHS.

On June 19th, Jenny Mallins delivers a fascinating insight into five generations of her family who lived in India during the days of the British Raj. Her presentation, entitled "Walking into Grandmother's Kitchen at Christmas: a British Rai lifestyle", contains an extensive collection of sepia photographs and the story of a 170 year-old cookbook penned by her four-times Grandmother in 1844.

And on July 17th Barry Hamblin talks about "Lavender, the Forgotten Herb". Barry explores the history of lavender, how it is grown, different varieties, its properties and uses. His talk is

based on his and his wife's experience running a lavender farm in Somerset.

As well as the monthly talks, Honiton u3a runs around 30 Activity Groups, ranging from Walking and Nature Appreciation, to Current Affairs and History, from Book Groups and Poetry Appreciation to Knitting and Crochet.

In addition, Honiton u3a has also recently organised several popular one-off events. These included a First Aid session for members, which gave those who attended essential practice in CPR and some awareness of Defibrillators. And new members were invited to a special meeting to meet the Committee and Activity Group leaders who were seeking potential new members.

This year, they have been examining the possibility of starting a group to play Pickleball, one of the country's fastest-growing sports.

Over the last 12 months, the group has welcomed 60 new members to its ranks. A spokesperson for Honiton u3a said that their ethos can be summed up in the famous quotation by the poet W. B. Yeats, who wrote: "There are no strangers here; only friends you haven't met yet."



EX I 4 AREA MAP HONITON TOWN MAP







#### FRIENDS OF HONITON STATION

Everyone in this country it seems loves a good anniversary. We are always looking back to the events of the past, sometimes with nostalgia, sometimes with a sigh of relief that those days are over. Such backward looking can sometimes help us think differently about the present, and come up with ways to improve the future. There is an old saying, that if we don't learn the lessons of the past, we are doomed to repeat it.

Railway people are no exception. Recently, I read Christian Wolmar's latest book on the history of British Rail. As well as de-bunking some tired old myths about BR, such as the disgusting sandwiches, it was fascinating to see how for generations the benefits of a coherent railway network were undervalued, while road travel was seen as the answer to every question.

It is only now that we are seeing how short-sighted that view was, and how hard it is to reverse decades of under-investment or station closures, to rebuild a network fit for a de-carbonised future.

How different it all looked in the Victorian era. If anything, the problem then was that too many groups, often with conflicting agendas, sought

to build railways here, there and everywhere, without any overall plan. Lines often duplicated each other, or ran in areas where there was only a dubious need for a railway. No wonder it was dubbed "Railway Mania."

far. And railways which we now badly need to help alleviate road congestion around big cities or to provide a life-line to smaller communities just aren't there, or will cost a fortune to rebuild.

This will no doubt be on everyone's mind as we begin to plan for next year's big railway anniversary, Railway 200 which, as its name suggests, celebrates the opening of the first fullyfledged railway between Stockton and Darlington in 1825.

Railway 200 will be a great opportunity to remember the huge benefits that a national railway network has brought us, how surprisingly close we came 50 years ago to it being reduced to a skeleton of InterCity routes, with the Waterloo to Exeter line through Honiton closed and counties such as Cornwall cut off completely.

The anniversary will help us celebrate how, despite the overlaps and duplication, the Victorian pioneers have bequeathed to us a priceless gift: the means to travel across our country, for business or pleasure, without having to use our cars.

# Ancient tollroads

There was a recent success for the people, shopkeepers and motorists of Honiton, last month with the **scrapping** of the hugely unpopular proposal from DCC to introduce parking charges to the High Street.

Honiton, one of eight pilot towns in Devon, being trialled for the 'pay to park' scheme were unanimously shelved after a huge outcry from the community however, there were times when similar highway fees were not so reliant on public opinion! These negative, mutual feelings of charging the traveller hark back to the days of our grandparents' grandparents when tolls and turnpikes were the car tax of the time as this month we see the centenary of the end of the vast majority of the old West Country tolls!

Turnpike trusts were setup in the mid to late 18th century to fund dramatic improvements to the country's infrastructure, which had not been addressed for centuries. Under this scheme users of the turnpike roads would have to halt at tollhouses and pay a fee to use the next section of the highway. Honiton Turnpike Trust was formed in 1765 and at its height consisted of some twenty tollhouses.

Whilst the turnpikes tolls greatly improved the roads they were staggeringly unpopular and many found ingenious ways of getting around them. One such local rogue, a farmer from Awliscombe, travelled the course of the Gissage, still being a right of way, but with no tolls gates on the river bed. He frequently drove cattle, bought from the Honiton market, up to where the river meets Littletown, which was outside

the toll area. He was then able to ramble down the west side of town back to Awliscombe without passing any toll gates and thus got away without paying penny!

With the arrival of the railway and the decline in stage coach travel, by the second half of the nineteenth century, Turnpike Trusts were approaching financial ruin. In 1877, the majority of the Honiton toll houses were sold off and by 1885 all the town's turnpikes had been abandoned; however, surprisingly the tolls remained in many other places.

With the end of the era fast approaching in Totnes the toll gates were taken down and were publicly burnt yet it was not until June 2nd 1910 that the toll charges at Honiton were finally completely abolished. There was said to have been public "rejoicing" and "public entertainment" at the removal of these hugely unpopular charges. Honiton was, in fact, thought to be the last town to have had an active tollhouse. Most other West Country tolls, not including bridges, ended in April 1924 and the Road Traffic Act of 1930 finally brought a unanimous end to all the few remaining tolls gates.

Only three of the town's tollhouses survived into the twenty first century, one of which was sadly demolished with the arrival of the residential complex on the site of former Holyshute House. Today only two remain, one being the 'Copper Castle' on the A35 and 'Manna House' which lies just before Exeter Road meets the A30.

#### Stories of Honiton's multicultural past being researched and archived by volunteers for future generations

Stories of Honiton's multicutural past are being researched by volunteers, who have joined Telling Our Stories, Finding Our Roots. The history project, managed by Devon Development Education launched its Honiton branch at The Beehive community centre in November last year

The launch party was reported as being a great success with some important story leads already investigation. During the launch, Nepalese and Indian food was served by The Brave Gurkhas curry house and classical guitarist, Jose Rodrigo Jimenez Monroy entertained the small group of volunteers, project coordinators and heritage guests. Stories collected from previous projects have led to new educational resources, museum exhibitions, walking tours and a website - all points of success, shared by quest speakers at the launch, Sandhya Dave and Hilda Kalap.

Project Coordinator, Hilda Kalap said: "Devon has a long multicultural history that's not commonly known about, with the common view that Devon's population has always been white, Anglo-Saxon and monocultural. However, more evidence has and continues to emerge that the real history is quite

different. Volunteering on this project is a chance to be part of the story, gain new skills that could lead to a career, meet like-minded people, make new friends and create a more inclusive society for future

Volunteers who sign up for this exciting project in Honiton, which runs until the end of this year, are receiving training in archive research and oral history recording. An amazing amount of stories relating to people of many different nationalities who arrived in Honiton for a variety of reasons, married locally and settled in the town, are coming to light, such as the Irish labourers who were employed by George Wimpey to build Dunkeswell Airfield during WW2, the post war Polish servicemen, the Romany Gypsy community who annually visited Honiton Fair and the school for the children of former German POWs at Summerlands.

Other leads being researched include the Indian 'Ayah', Spanish Basque children staying at S'

Joseph's Missionary College (now St Rita's) during the **Spanish** Civil War, a school in Combe Raleigh during the Second World War, Fijian and Black American servicemen billeted in the locality and an important part of Honiton's history, already thoroughly researched for the 50th anniversary, Ugandan Asians at the Heathfield Resettlement Camp. Honiton Community Heritage Coordinator, Jess Huffman would love to hear from anyone who can add to any of the above stories, with family tales, photographs or artefacts. While some people may query what is the point of this project, others will marvel that their family stories are finally being told, seeing it as a legacy for future generations to understand how all the people, through the ages, and from not only outside of the town and county but who were born in other

countries, have helped to 'shape the life' of Honiton as it is today. Jess said that "watching people's faces light up" when she talks to them about the project and they begin to "think of their own family history and heritage is illuminating."

For the grand-daughter of Timothy O'Brien, an Irish worker at Dunkeswell Airfield, who was also on Air Raid Patrol during WW2 and a valid member of the Royal British Legion Club in Dowell Street, Honiton, recording the town's multicultural past and its tolerance to outsiders who put down roots there is "more important now than ever before."

N.B. Devon's Multicultural History project - Telling Our Stories. Finding Our Roots is managed by the global learning charity, Devon Development Education (DDE). Funded by the National Lottery Heritage Fund, the project is continuing in Honiton and in Ilfracombe during 2023/2024 and follows on from similar projects in Exeter (2013), Tiverton, Bideford and Okehampton (2019-2020). Facts that have been uncovered in DDE's previous successful projects, include the historical verification that Exeter had a sizeable population of French Hugenots by 1715 and that 'enslaved people' were freed at a crossroads in Okehampton, as far back as 980 AD. The charity, which is based in Exeter, has over 20 years experience of providing expertise to schools and communities in Devon. Its main aim is to 'provide a window on the world, to enable children and adults to understand links between their own lives and those of others worldwide'. The hope being that by working together, people will 'help to create a just and sustainable world for everyone.'


