Brownfield Development

2023 saw a boost to Government initiatives for disused and unloved brownfield sites across England to be regenerated. These initiatives include up to £180 million pounds of funding to help deliver thousands of new homes and jobs across England, from Exeter to Sunderland.

The funding will deliver 5,800 new homes by March 2027, create around 18,000 new jobs in the housing and construction sector. All on previously developed, but now redundant land. (All according to UK Government sources.)

Well, here in Honiton Town Centre an innovative brown-field development has been underway since July 2022, when Churchill Retirement Living finally achieved planning consent for the erection of 57 one-bedroom and two-bedroom retirement flats. The site - in Silver Street. Honiton - had been Honiton Livestock Market for many years. Originally run by local auctioneers TD Hussey and Sons, before they were taken over by regional agricultural and property agents Stags, this was a popular venue for famers and buyers to meet every week. However, due to the size and number of vehicles

accessing the town centre site, and rationalisation of livestock markets to larger centres such as Exeter & Bridgwater, closure in early 2022 was inevitable.

Appropriately named "Otter Lodge", occupation of the flats currently under construction is restricted to those of 60 years plus. However the location will be most attractive to that age-group, giving easy access to all that Honiton has to offer, including the railway station, Allhallows Museum and The Beehive. And just 5 minutes walk from Honiton High Street, this is a perfect location for residents to enjoy all that the centre of town offers; and will contribute greatly to re-vitalising the retail and hospitality businesses.

So this is a classic "brownfield development", right in the centre of Honiton Town.

Ever wondered about the massive crane in the Town Centre, with the red warning light at night? Well this is the electrically

operated

tower

crane which transports all the materials around the construction site at Otter Lodge.

Naturally Churchill Retirement Living make much of East Devon as being an attractive area to live – which we all know to be true! ON STREET PARKING SURVEY

Honiton Chamber of Commerce and Industry fully supported Honiton Town Council in its endeavours to obtain the viewpoint of local people by means of a survey concerning planned introduction by Devon County Council of parking meters on Honiton High Street. To this end the Chamber set up an online survey and received from the Town Councillors concerned hand written survey forms obtained over a period of time from members of the public in Honiton High Street and carefully collated the same. The survey identified four main groups of High Street users; Local Residents, Retailers, Visitors and those Who Work Locally. Across all four groups the results indicate that a majority would "Visit Less Often" or "Not At All" and these replies amounted to 88% of the total with only 0.24% indicating it would increase their use of the High Street.

This is damning condemnation of the plan by Devon County Council and I trust they too will acknowledge the feelings expressed by their own electorate that this measure would cause severe harm to the commerce, community and tourism of Honiton Town. Many participants commented that it would be the "End Of Honiton"!

There is some concern that the person behind the scheme is Honiton's own Devon County Councillor Phillip Twiss and we would hope that he will take on board the feeling of his townsfolk and put an end to this scheme before it leaves County Hall and damages Honiton and the seven other towns identified as suitable for High Street parking meters.


We are delighted to have received this prestigious

The Old Honiton Cattle Market

Many of you will have become very aware of the red glow that has dominated the night skyline behind the High Street for the past several months. So much so that on one misty summer evening social media pages, devoted to Honiton news and gossip, shared pictures of an apparent strange craft emitting a hazy red glow beneath it and an imminent curiosity of visitations from little green men! Whilst 'War of the Worlds' didn't come to Honiton that night this red light is the beacon that stands atop of a crane in Silver Street, presently engaged in construction of retirement properties on the former Honiton Cattle Market.

The market has historically been held in the High Street where for centuries farmers and traders alike would bring their livestock to town twice or thrice a week to sell and buy. The market traders operated from pitches, which belonged to the market and were rented out each week from where they were stored; in the old pannier market. The top floor of this ancient building, opened in 1824, served as the ballroom for the old Dolphin Hotel, whilst the down stairs provided storage for the market stalls and also was the place where poultry and dairy products were sold.

With the arrival of the motor car, in the early 20th century, the High Street started to become

rather crowded with sheep, horses, cows and swine being sold on a then busy highway so it was decided to relocate the livestock side to a new site in Silver Street. Land was purchased from, local farmer and Town Alderman, Thomas Cox Rolstone, by the then Lord of the Manor, and holder of the market rights, Richard Marker who funded the entire venture. The opening ceremony took place on October 8th 1910 and the event was stated to have drawn a 'large attendance' including member of the then Borough Council including the Mayor and Town Clerk. It is somewhat ironic that less than twenty years later the Borough Council would become custodians of the market rights, having leased them from the Lord of the Manor for a period of 210 years from 1939.

The market operated successfully for nearly one hundred years until the foot and mouth outbreak of 2001 halted trade and the proceeding years saw a whole change in how and when livestock were sold. Many will recall furniture auction or car boot sales taking place in there since but in 2022 it was announced the whole redundant site was to be developed into residential housing.

Just inside the old entrance to the market was placed a white engraved stone marking the occasion of the opening ceremony which has since been removed and now resides in Allhallows Museum.
